FEDERAL TRADE COMMISSION PROPOSAL ON BANNING NON-COMPETE CLAUSES - SUPPLEMENT

In our previous Alert dated January 10th, we updated you on the Federal Trade Commission's Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NPRM) regarding a sweeping ban on non-compete agreements.

While associations, professional societies and other business leagues likely are subject to the proposed rule, some charitable and education nonprofits may be outside the jurisdiction of the Federal Trade Commission. Even such nonprofits, however, should carefully consider whether state or local law would restrict their ability to enter into enforceable non-compete agreements. Non-compete agreements are under increasing scrutiny, not just at the Federal level.

As a reminder, comments on the FTC's proposed rule must be received by no later than March 20, 2023.
